Stefanie Pukallus, PhD, is Professor of Public Communication and Civil Development at the School of Information, Journalism and Communication at the University of Sheffield (UK) and founding Chair of Hub for the Study of Hybrid Communication in Peacebuilding (HCPB).

Stef's research focus is the role of public communication in the development, strengthening, rebuilding, diminishment or destruction of civil society. She examines civil societies across the globe of both mature and emergent nature. Her most recent book 'Contestation in Civil Society. Noise, listening and civil action' was published in April 2025 and she is currently working on her next book on the civil-political logic of internal exile.

Stef has undertaken consultancy for the United Nations, the European Commission and the European Parliament. She is also a close collaborator of the Centre for Freedom of the Media (CFOM) and has been involved in a variety of peacebuilding and anti-violent extremism initiatives in Kenya and East Africa more widely.
